40th Birthday Celebration and Conversion to Primary

As you may be aware we will be holding a celebration to mark our 40th Birthday and conversion to a Primary School.

Please enter via the gates by Year 5, anyone who is late must wait at the back until there is a suitable break in the celebration.**

Each year group will learn a song from a particular decade starting from the 1977 to 2017 to sing. This will be followed by the cutting of the ribbon and the official opening of our new building.

Programmes will be for sale on the gate for 50p. You will receive a numbered lucky programme. After the opening ceremony, a lucky programme number will be drawn for an exciting prize. We will not be limiting the amount of people per family but we do ask that you bring a seat or deckchair to sit on for the duration of the event. Accompanying younger siblings will receive a celebration cake (subject to availability).

The PTFA will also be organising a BBQ and selling refreshments whilst you enjoy the celebrations. These will be large hot dogs £2, small hot dogs £1, burgers £2 and samosas 60p each.
